

As approved by the SACSCOC Board, "Institutional Obligation for Public Disclosure", requires that member institutions publish "statements of its goals for student achievement and the success of students in achieving those goals." Allen University uses several measures to evaluate student achievement and success in accordance with the University's mission and strategic plan.

Mission Statement:

Allen University is an academic community which provides students an opportunity to obtain a baccalaureate degree in liberal arts and professional programs. The University has a strong unalterable commitment to teaching in delivery of its baccalaureate programs.

Allen University monitors its enrollment trends as a means for exploring methods to improve the success of its students and for the purpose of raising the profile of the university. Primarily, results in evaluating enrollment trends demonstrate an overall decrease. However, Allen University's three (3) year enrollment average is 646 students which serves as the University benchmark. See the following table.

The University's goal is to have an annual 5% increase in the number of graduates working in the discipline. According to data recorded for the last three years, the Alumni Survey shows that 3 (14.2%), 14 (31.1%), and 19 (36.5%) graduates were employed in their discipline during the 2012, 2013, and 2014 academic years, respectively.
